Maltsmiths – 4.6% - Edinburgh. £4.75 – 2.7 units

Maltsmiths Pilsner Style Lager is a German Pilsner style beer brewed by The Caledonian Brewing Company in Edinburgh. The perfect refreshment. A crisp, clean lager with pine, citrus and earthy hop notes. Our beer goes beautifully with a burger or some spicy fajitas.

Belhaven Best – 3.2% - Belhaven. £4.75 – 1.8 units

Belhaven - or "The Beautiful Harbour" nestles among the rolling barley fields of Scotland's beautiful East Coast. For nearly 300 years, they have brewed in this place using only the finest ingredients. Their flagship beer, Belhaven Best a sweet malty beer with lots of toffee & caramel notes from the pale and crystal malts. Fresh dry hop taste comes from the challenger and goldings which also give a satisfying easy drinking bitter finish.

Carlsberg Lager – 3.8% - Denmark. £4.75 – 2.1 units

At Carlsberg, the pursuit of better beer is in their DNA. More than 100 years after founder J.C. Jacobsen mastered the art of brewing great Pilsner, they are still looking for ways to improve their beer. This perfectly balanced Danish Pilsner is wonderfully crisp and refreshing, with a full flavour and a distinctive hoppy aroma.

Thatcher's Gold – 4.8% - North Somerset. £4.90 – 2.8 units

This crafted Somerset cider is full of flavour blended from the highest quality apples, made using traditional techniques and expertise gained since 1904 on the family's farm in North Somerset, Myrtle Farm. A medium dry golden cider, with a smooth and refreshing taste.

Guinness – 4.1% - Dublin. £4.90 – 2.3 units

Guinness brewers were the first to introduce the combination of nitrogen and carbon dioxide to draught beer. The result was Guinness Draught, famous for its smooth velvety texture and unique surge and settle. Guinness has a malty sweetness and a hoppy bitterness, with notes of coffee and chocolate. A roasted flavour also comes through, courtesy of the roasted unmalted barley that goes into its brewing. It has a sweet nose, with hints of malt breaking through, and its palate is smooth, creamy, and balanced.

Ice Breaker Pale Ale – 4.5% - Suffolk. £4.90 - 2.6 units

Ice Breaker is triple hopped with Citra and Simcoe to deliver citrus and tropical fruit aromas and tastes, complimented with fresh pine resin and a crisp bitterness. Pale and amber malts give balanced sweetness and the addition of carapils malt and torrefied wheat contributes body and mouthfeel.

San Miguel – 5% - The Philippines. £5.05 – 2.8 units

San Miguel Especial is a premium pilsner style lager, golden in colour, sparkling with a generous white creamy head and citrus aroma. San Miguel perfectly balance bitterness to deliver full-bodied beer with a clean, crisp and refreshing taste. San Miguel Especial lager has flavours of white bread, fruit, white flowers and liquorice. The beer has a subtle finish of

roasted cereal and a pleasant balance between the sweetness of yeast and the mild bitterness of hops.

Koppaberg Strawberry and Lime – 4% - Sweden. £4.90 – 2.3 units

Built back in 1882, the Kopparberg Bryggeri remains independent and is home to their uniquely refreshing fruit cider. A pioneer, Kopparberg was the first fruit cider in the UK and is today the bestselling fruit cider brand in the UK. Every drop of Kopparberg is imported and made from the fermentation of apples or pears and the finest soft water, locally sourced in the town of Kopparberg, Sweden.

Budweiser Lager Beer – 4.5% - St. Louis. £3.85 – 1.5 units

Known as “The King of Beers,” Budweiser was first introduced by Adolphus Busch in 1876 and it’s still brewed with the same high standards today. Budweiser is a medium-bodied, flavourful, crisp American-style lager. Brewed with the best barley malt and a blend of premium hop varieties, it is an icon of core American values like optimism and celebration.

Peroni – 5% - Rome. £3.85 – 1.7 units

Bombay Sapphire – 40% - Warrington. £3.95 – 1.4 units

Bombay Sapphire is distilled in England and is made with a base of neutral spirits that are distilled from wheat and malt. The gin is then flavoured with a blend of ten botanical ingredients using a slow infusion process, including juniper berries, coriander seeds, citrus peel, and liquorice root.

Edinburgh Gin – 43% - Edinburgh. £3.95 – 1.6 units

This delicious gin is distilled in Edinburgh and is flavoured with lovely botanicals including milk thistle and heather. A very creamy little gin.

Gordon's London Dry – 37.5% - Cameron Bridge. £2.85 – 1.3 units

A gin that needs no introduction. Gordon's is a very popular dry gin first created in 1769 by Alexander Gordon. The recipe is only known by four people, and has been a secret for 200 years.

Hendrick's – 41.4% - Girvan. £4.20 – 1.4 units

This terrific Scottish gin is made using two different stills - the Bennett still steeps its botanicals overnight before distillation, while the Carter-Head has its botanicals in a basket up in the still neck, steaming them gently. It features the likes of juniper, cubeb berries, elderflower, chamomile, angelica, lemon peel, orange peel, coriander, yarrow and orris, alongside an infusion of cucumber and rose petal.

Lilliard Gin – 40% - Jedburgh. £3.95 – 1.4 units

Scottish gin made in the heart of the Scottish Borders, named for a heroine of the Battle of Ancrum Moor. Rowan, rosehip, meadowsweet and elderflower combine with juniper to create an elegant, floral gin that embodies the four fragrant seasons of our Border valleys.

Sipsmith – 41.6% - London. £3.95 – 1.5 units

This super-small-batch artisanal Gin is flavoured with restraint, making it easier for the natural quality of the spirit to shine through. Distilled in a marvellously compact pot still / column still combo named Prudence, Sipsmith epitomises distilling on a truly artisanal scale. At the time of her installation, Prudence was the first copper pot still to be brought to life in London for over 200 years.

Captain Morgans Original Spiced – 35% - Jamaica. £3.00 – 1.2 units

Smooth and medium bodied, Captain Morgan's Spiced is based on a secret blend of premium Caribbean rums, mellow spice and other natural flavours.

Captain Morgans Original Dark –40 % - Jamaica. £3.00 – 1.4 units

Baileys Irish Cream – 17% - Dublin. £3.20 – 0.8 units

The cream liqueur that needs little introduction! Baileys is made with cream, Irish whiskey and cocoa, and it's very, very more-ish. This is the world's most popular liqueur.

Chambord – 16.5% - France. £3.40 – 0.6 units

Chambord is a world-renowned raspberry liqueur which was first produced in the Loire valley in the 1600s. It is made with black raspberries, vanilla from Madagascar and Moroccan citrus peels which are steeped in cognac and sweetened with honey.

Courvoisier VS – 40% - France. £4.00 – 1.4 units

Courvoisier proudly boast their Cognac as that of Napoleon. It all started when Napoleon took hundreds of bottles of Courvoisier Cognac for his years of exile.
